- Principal report:
 - Justin Saulnier introduction – Acting Vice Principal
 - 394 students – kindergarten down 20 students
 - new playground next summer – have 2 suppliers, get parental input
 - School improvement goals – 80% of grades 1-3 are reading at or above grade level – using F&P tests
 - Grade 1 – 87% at/above, Grade 2 – 89% at/above, Grade 3 – 92% at/above – This year will continue with that goal
 - Excellence in Teaching Award – Jaime Grant
 - Financial report – available next meetings

SCC:

- Hot lunch – Heather takes care of organizing
 - Hot lunch survey last school year – discuss results at executive meeting and any changes
 - Heather needs a couple of volunteers to help out with being at the school on hot lunch days
 - Every hot lunch a grade will be assigned to target volunteers
 - 3rd week of the month is hot lunch
 - Brandi Schwenk and Melody Schmitke have volunteered to help Heather out
 - Nutritional guides have to be followed for hot lunches – we've been following that
 - Volunteers needed for mouth rinse, immunizations and Picture Day
 - Picture day is October 8 & 9 – Danielle will help
 - No dates for immunizations yet (possibly October 7)
 - Mouth rinse – Tuesday mornings (but could be any day) – Brandy, Danielle, and Amber have volunteered
 - Division 1 & 2 community food drive – donations are split with half staying for our breakfast program and half go to the food bank – 1 classroom from each division wins a party (who ever collects the most items) – we'll have it run in November
 - Diane motions food drive in November, Danielle seconds motion
 - Educational Programming – proceeds from the garage sale
 - all teachers choose something from their curriculum that they would like to do as a grade and SCC gives each class up to \$100/class and possibly supply SCC volunteers
 - Library needs help – some of the money could possibly go to that
 - Parents that have a talent or skill or something they would like to or could offer a classroom
