 - We have a popcorn make with a cart – paid under \$500
 - School Improvement – Goal is to 84% of grades 1-6 students reading at or above grade level – students at grade level or just below, the goal is to help them move up
 - School visitor plan – an LPSD standard
- Front door unlocked
 - All other doors unlocked – only until after morning recess
 - not signage at all doors yet
 - supervisors have keys to the doors

- school plan to identify visitors – we need to have a consistent staff plan
- we have a staff plan to address individuals that are not part of the school community
- all visitors sign in and visitor badges
 - Movie day – December 17 – wondering about SCC members who would like to help out
 - does anyone have a large popcorn maker?
- maybe we could make it all the day before
- December 16 4pm-6pm we could pop the popcorn and bag it all – we'll send out an email looking for volunteers
 - December Hot lunch – December 15 snack – maybe this year we do oranges and juice boxes instead of hot chocolate and popcorn? Could we possibly get a Sobey's donations
- Stephanie made a motion to change the snack to oranges and juice boxes / Danielle seconded
 - Danielle made a motion to OK last months minutes/Samantha seconded
 - Heather's teaching schedule has changed she won't be able to make the meetings
 - Booster Juice went over well
 - November hot lunch – Personal Pizza from Boston Pizza Nov 25 & 26, \$4/pizza there is Gluten Free option as well for the same price – We need the volunteers to pick up then distribute
 - Keri Kort to possibly make some homemade hot lunches – reasonable prices – February possible soup and bun
 - Nancy at Delish – she's going to cater the staff appreciation lunch in February
 - Christmas Hampers – We're not going to do them this year but we are making sure that any families in need will be directed to the Salvation Army and/or First Baptist Church for help – we're going to focus more on education
 - Marcia mentioned maybe a mitten tree set up by the office that parents and students could donate hats, mitts and scarves to and decorate the tree with – those items could be donated, some kept at the school for students that don't have any – our focus this year may just be the food drive
 - Food Drive extended to December 4 – Division 1 will collect cereal and juice boxes, Division 2 collect granola bars and fruit cups – one class from each division who collects the most items will win a pancake party
- we'll send out an email looking for volunteers to help sort, count and deliver
- December 11 will be the pancake party, we'll do both classes together, we'll ask for volunteers from the winning classrooms parents first
 - Educational Fund – Kari-Lynn hasn't heard from any teachers yet who would like to utilize it
 - Family Movie night first week of February – sell tickets for how many people allowed in the gym (fire code) – movie to be announced, we can discuss at January meetings
